This edition supersedes the 164-entry checkpoint dated 19 August 2026. It preserves the complete 164-row grid unchanged and adds 38 further individually identified care/residential-linked public-record cases.

Evidence and classification caution. The added tranche includes direct residential staff and housemasters, foster carers, institutional-access offenders, one residential peer case, and some cases where the conviction did not itself involve a resident of the named institution. Those distinctions are retained in the row notes. A conviction is not inferred from an allegation, charge, caution, acquittal or a trial-of-the-facts finding.

Source standard. The additions were drawn from public records including IICSA, the National Crime Agency, COPFS, Police Scotland, the Attorney General/GOV.UK and related official material. Where a source did not state a sentence, the row says so rather than supplying one.

Document structure. Page 1 is this 202-entry update notice. The original 164-entry checkpoint follows unchanged. The final appendix adds rows 165-202.

Research-use caution. This is a working research inventory, not a prevalence estimate and not a claim that all 202 people held the same type of office, employment or institutional authority.

This edition retains the existing 100-entry master grid and adds **64 further care/residential-focused public-record rows**. The new rows were deduplicated against the previous 100-entry PDF before insertion.

New-tranche legal-status check: 63 of the 64 added rows have a documented criminal conviction in the cited public source. One row - Malcolm Phillips - is deliberately classified separately because the 2026 proceeding was a trial of the facts after he was found unfit to stand trial; it did not produce a criminal conviction in that proceeding.

Role/access caution: the care/residential tranche is not homogeneous. Most rows concern staff, carers, foster carers, managers, teachers or other adults with institutional access. Gareth Stephenson is retained as a residential-school peer case and is explicitly marked as *not staff/authority*. A few IICSA foster-care annex rows concern offences where the cited victim was not actually in care; those caveats are preserved in the row rather than being hidden.

Evidence standard: official inquiry, prosecution, police or other public-body sources are preferred. Where an official inquiry records the conviction but does not state the sentence in the cited summary, the grid says so instead of inventing a disposal. This document is a working research index and should not be read as proof of any wider conspiracy or as a statistical estimate of offending in the care sector.

Next research pass: continue through IICSA residential-care and institutional investigations, North Wales / Operation Pallial material, CPS/PPS/COPFS and police archives, then deduplicate new names against this 164-row checkpoint.

LCS / Labour25 - Full 79 Legal-Status Working Grid

Corrected full-list edition - 19 August 2026

What this is: all 79 numbered entries from the expanded Labour25 source inventory, classified using the legal-status scheme requested: **Convicted and sentenced; Cautioned + sex-offender notification requirements; Charged; Arrested only; Unverified**. This replaces the earlier truncated PDF.

Evidence rule: a conviction/caution is stated as such only where the source wording or a later verification source supports it. An arrest or charge is not upgraded to a conviction without later outcome evidence. Rows marked **Labour25 source-list wording only** are a source inventory, not an independent finding. The classification is procedural, not a measure of seriousness.

Important terminology: in UK indecent-image law, "making" can include downloading/copying an image; it does not by itself prove that the defendant physically filmed the abuse. For cautions, Hansard records that adults cautioned for qualifying offences under s.1 Protection of Children Act 1978 or s.160 Criminal Justice Act 1988 are subject to Part 2 notification requirements.

Audit notes and limitations

1. The 79 is the expanded Labour25 source-list count. It is not a count of 79 unique offenders spoken in the 5 hour 27 minute broadcast. Rangy reads a concentrated original list at the beginning of the programme and then moves into wider discussion/callers.
2. Rows marked "Labour25 source-list wording only" have not yet been independently checked against a court, CPS/police release, council record or established news report in this pass. They remain useful as leads, but should not be presented as independently verified convictions until corroborated.
3. Mark Trotter is deliberately classified Unverified in the criminal-outcome column because he died before arrest/prosecution. Separate inquiries later concluded that abuse had occurred and criticised institutional failures; that is not the same thing as a criminal conviction.
4. Raymond Coates is deliberately classified Charged: his trial was stayed on medical grounds. A stayed/unresolved prosecution is neither an acquittal nor a conviction.
5. The legal-status categories distinguish procedural outcome, not seriousness. A qualifying caution can carry sex-offender notification requirements even though it is not a conviction.
6. Next evidential pass: independently corroborate every remaining source-only conviction entry and every unresolved arrest/charge, then add exact court, date, sentence/disposal and a reputable source URL to each row.
